FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a right side perspective view of a modified form of the design shown in FIGS. 1 through 4;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;


FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof; and,


FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof.












